One of his favorite things was how many people from many different cultures he met.

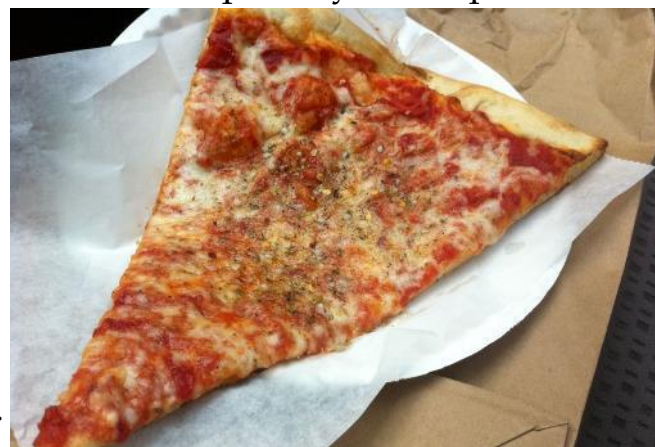
