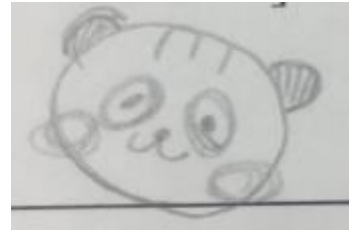


Our Hirosho School Life!
